To provide comprehensive resettlement assistance to endangered wartime allies who served U.S. interests in conflict and war zones.



What We Do



Keeping Our Promise Inc. offers a comprehensive resettlement support program for Afghan, Iraqi and Kurds in the greater Rochester, NY region who served the United States interests in Afghanistan and Iraq.

KOP Program Criteria: Who We Assist

- Afghans or Iraqis who were interpreters or support personnel for the U.S. military or Embassy for 1 year or more.
- Afghans who work/worked on a full-time basis as contractors, Locally Engaged Staff (LES), or interpreters/translators for the U.S. Government, USFOR-A, ISAF, or Resolute Support.
- Afghans who worked for a U.S. government-funded program or project in Afghanistan supported through a U.S. government grant or cooperative agreement.
- Afghans who are/were employed in Afghanistan by a U.S.-based media organization or nongovernmental organization, who are referred to the U.S. government by an American senior employee of these organizations or referred to the U.S. government by the Embassy.

Over the last 8 years we have been able to assist over 600 Pashtuns, Uzbeks, Tajiks, Hazara, Turkmen and Nuristanis from Afghanistan, Sunni and Shia Iraqis, as well as Kurdish allies who now call Rochester, NY home.

A Message From Our Director

Dear friends and supporters,

It has been a hard year, but you helped 74 Afghan families totaling 219 individuals resettle in the greater Rochester, NY area. The majority – 195 individuals – arrived since July 4. A record for our program. A year ago I wrote that our goal was to resettle 15-20 families, and we helped 54 families more than planned.

Admittedly, it has been absolutely exhausting for the volunteers and staff of our program, stretching us beyond our capacity. Supporters helped with financial resources to pay for rent, security and food for our allies who escaped the Taliban. Those of you here helped with setting up apartments – 66

apartments in all. You made sure that every family had furniture, a complete kitchen setup, food, hygiene essentials, and you made sure children had toys and picture books.

To give you a perspective of the enormity of the evacuation of Afghans who helped us: In August, **Keeping Our Promise** had the names of 2,330 individuals seeking to be evacuated. We were instructed to create lists that the government would use for consideration of who to evacuate, with a focus on "high profile" targets. There were tough, heart-breaking decisions on who to recommend with a laser-focus on those with complete document packages and passports in hand. Recommendations were forwarded to Congressman Morelle's office on an hourly basis. None of us seemed to be able to type fast enough. We had to include photos of each family and descriptions of what they were wearing to assist "retrieval." As we watched the Taliban take over Kabul our hearts were breaking and sleep was impossible. The photos haunt me. So many did not make it out.

The majority of our Afghan allies in Rochester who arrived after August were admitted to the U.S. under the "Humanitarian Parole" program. While vital, this program only protects our Afghan friends from deportation **for two years**. Families must continue with their Special Immigrant paperwork or file for asylum by August 2022 - a mere six months from now. Questions remain on how the government will process the onslaught of paperwork.

The alternative to this humanitarian crisis is for Congress to pass a bill called the **Afghan Adjustment Act**, modeled after the Cuban Adjustment Act. This would allow our Afghan families to file for Legal Permanent Residence after being paroled for one year. It is the bare minimum we can do for those who worked along side of us.

It is hard to place into words my gratitude for our volunteers, financial donors, SIVs and community partners who have formed bonds of friendship and commitment to make this all work. You are all doing tremendous good, and changing the world for the better as we are all work together as neighbors and as a country to keep our promise to those Afghans who supported us against the Taliban and ISIL.

Thank you for joining together in dedication to this mission and Keeping Our Promise.

2021 Program Highlights



74 Afghan families totaling 219 individuals

were resettled in the greater Rochester, NY area. The majority – 195 individuals – arrived since July 4. A record for our program, and straining our volunteer capacity.

18 Emergency Flights

Thanks to those who donated frequent flyer miles to our partner **Miles4Migrants**, we were able to secure emergency flights for 18 individuals who were in immediate danger of Taliban or ISIL reprisal. Each ticket out of Kabul required 45,000 donated "miles." A total of 810,000 miles were donated to help!





66 Apartments Furnished

Volunteers fully furnish all apartments for each family for free thanks to donations from the local community. We furnished 66 apartments and houses for our allies. Saints Place furnished eight apartments when we were stretched for manpower and beds! We were also able to purchase 50 new beds below cost from Saints Place.

20 Food Baskets Every Month

Asbury Methodist Church provided 20 food baskets for our most vulnerable families who have no benefits when they first arrive.

Eight Car Grants

Our Wheels-for-Work car grant program requires each family to log 100 hours of community service, have their NYS driver's license and be ready for work or have employment to qualify for a vehicle. We have helped over 100 families since 2015 with cars. All tell us that a vehicle changed their life for the better.



We are grateful to the Summers Foundation Inc. for supporting our car grant program in 2021.





Our car grants in 2021 included a wheelchair accessible van for a couple where the husband was left a quadriplagic by a suicide bomber. A grant from the first Unitarian Church will help with driving lessons.

FACT: Families with cars are twice as likely to find a job and four times as likely to stay employed, a finding that's consistent with another common reality for the low-income: Unreliable transportation is one of the primary reasons why they lose their jobs. Many employers will not hire someone without a car. ¹

Monroe County Executive Adam Bello Announces Veteran Recognition for SIVs



On Sept. 7, 2021, **Monroe County Executive Adam Bello** directed the Monroe County Veterans Service Agency to recognize our SIVs who served the U.S. as "veterans" qualifying them for benefits and other public assistance. Many of our SIVs were in attendance telling their stories to the press of the situation in Afghanistan, and the hardships they face coming to our community when their work history is not understood.

Agency and a veteran who served multiple tours in Afghanistan told the Sept. 7 audience, "To me these SIVs are our brothers and sisters, and I am glad we are opening a new door today and recognizing them. I hope companies and the rest of the community recognizes the service they gave to this country and the threats that their families are under right now."

When talking previously about the evacuation and fall of the country to the Taliban, Stefanovic said, "It's been like my heart gets ripped out....We stopped the public executions, we stopped the enslavement of women, we allowed girls to go to school again.... Those people lived free after we liberated them."²

It was also announced Sept 7 that the Rochester Education and Opportunity Center would open its doors to Afghans evacuees who previously had to wait a year to attend the trade school due to NYS residency requirements. This requirement shut out many SIVs from pursuing certification for their careers they held in Afghanistan to the detriment of being able to support their family, and to the detriment of our employers looking for skilled labor. There is still a residency requirement for SUNY colleges, and we are working to change this requirement.


